LIQUOR ORDINANCE 1955

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 9 of 1955

This Ordinance varies the trading hours in the Territory. From the 1st October 1955, trading hours will be –

- (a) from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. for hotels, clubs and restaurants,
- (b) ordinary shop trading hours for grocers, and
- (c) in the case of booths the hours specified by the Registrar or the Magistrate in granting each particular application.

The minimum price of a meal with which liquor may be served in a hotel, club or restaurant has been raised from 2/6 to 5/-.

Restaurants will be able to serve any type of liquor, not only light wines and malted liquors, as at present.
