LEASES ORDINANCE 1955

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 10 of 1955

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the limitation that the maximum period of a lease granted under this Ordinance should be twenty-five years. It is proposed to make regulations prescribing a maximum period of fifty years for leases for grazing, fruit-growing, horticultural agricultural or dairying purposes and ninety-nine years for leases for other purposes.

The opportunity has been taken to eliminate out-of-date or unnecessary references to officers of the Department of the Interior.
