

Public Place Names (Crace) Determination 2011 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2011-240

made under the

Public Place Names Act 1989 — section 3 (Minister to determine names)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, notified in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate.

Section 46 of the *Legislation Act 2001* specifies that power given under an Act to make an instrument includes power to amend or repeal the instrument.

This instrument AMENDS DI2009 – 77 by revoking one name in the Division of Crace (Keewong Crescent) as specified in the attached Schedule A; and

DETERMINES the names of new roads in the Division of Crace as specified in the attached Schedule B and associated plan. The theme for the naming of public places in Crace is *parishes and land divisions*.

The original road configuration notified in DI2009 – 77 has changed requiring an amendment to the road name. The road is now determined in this instrument as Keewong Street.
