

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
INSTRUMENT NO. 285 OF 2001
APPOINTMENTS TO THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY
LONG SERVICE LEAVE BOARD

The Construction Industry Long Service Leave Board was established by section 4 of the *Long Service Leave (Building and Construction Industry) Act 1981* (“the Act”).

Subsection 8 (1) of the Act stipulates that the Board shall consist of (a) the Chairperson; (b) a member representing employer organisations; and (c) a member representing employee organisations.

By subsection 8 (2) of the Act the members of the Board are to be appointed by the Minister and shall hold office for up to 5 years, as stated in the member’s appointment. Section 9 of the Act enables the Minister to appoint acting members of the Board, who may act in place of the appointed member for up to one year during the member’s absence.

The following is an instrument of appointment for Robert Yeomans as Chairperson of the Board, effective from the date of Gazettal to 27 February 2003. Also following are instruments of appointment for John Haskins as a Member of the Board, Brian O’Reilly as a Member of the Board, John Hailey as an Acting Member of the Board, and George Wason as an Acting Member of the Board, effective from the date of Gazettal to 23 September 2004.

Pursuant to section 4 of the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*, these appointments were endorsed by the Legislative Assembly’s Standing Committee on Planning and Urban Services on 24 August 2001.
