# Road Transport (General) (Pay Parking Area Fees) Determination 2011 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2011—307

made under the

*Road Transport (General) Act 1999*, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the road transport legislation.

This determination continues to set the relevant parking fees for Territory-operated pay parking areas. Under the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000*, pay parking areas fall into two categories: metered parking areas (which are established by the road transport authority under section 73(1) of the Regulation) and ticket parking schemes (which are established by the authority under section 76(1) of the Regulation, including the CIT Student Prepaid Ticket Parking Scheme).

Clause 8 of the *Road Transport (General) (Pay Parking Area Fees) Determination 2011 (No. 2)* instrument refers to the definition of an *eligible CIT student* (for the purpose of the CIT Student Prepaid Ticket Parking Scheme) to clause 5 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Canberra Institute of Technology Student Pre-paid Ticket Parking Scheme 2011* NI2011-663. Under NI2011-663 the definition of an *eligible CIT student* has been expanded.

No increase or change has been made to the pay parking fees in this instrument.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
