RABBIT DESTRUCTION REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 12 of 1982

The Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919 makes provision for the control of rabbits and other noxious animals in the Territory. Consequential upon the introduction of the Nature Conservation Ordinance 1980, which makes provision for the protection of native fauna and flora in the Territory, the Rabbit Destruction Regulations (Amendment) removes certain obsolete provisions in those Regulations dealing with the erection of rabbit-proof fences and the issue of permits to kill or take natural enemies of the rabbit and raises the fee for a permit to keep live rabbits or hares from \$1 to \$10.
