PHARMACY REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)
EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 21 of 1982

The Minister for Health has made regulations under the Pharmacy Ordinance 1931.

The regulations repeal regulation 6 which is no longer required because of an amendment to the Ordinance. The same amendment to the Ordinance introduced the requirement that a number of new fees be prescribed by regulation. The regulations therefore repeal regulation 5 which previously prescribed a fee for the issue of a certificate of registration of \$2.10 and the issue of a temporary permit without fee and substitute a new table of fees which amongst other things increases the fee of \$2.10 and introduces a fee for temporary registration which has replaced the system of temporary permits.

The new fees are as follows:

Sub-section 30(1)	Fee for temporary registration as a locum tenens	\$20
Sub-section 30(2)	fee for renewal of temporary registration	\$20
Sub-section 31(2)	fee for special registration for research or educational purposes	\$50
Sub-section 31(3)	fee for renewal of special registration	\$50
Paragraph 48(1)(a)	fee for inspection of an entry in the Register	\$ 1
Paragraph 48(1)(b)	fee for a certified copy of an entry in the Register	\$ 2
