BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 33 of 1982

The Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations (Amendment) amend regulation 39 and the Schedule to the Boilers and Pressures Vessels Regulations by increasing the fees for the issue of a boiler attendant's certificate and for the inspection of boilers and pressure vessels.

Details of the former and new fees are set out below.

Regulation 1 amends regulation 39 as follows:

Regulation 2 amends the Schedule to the regulations as follows:

Boiler inspected

Locomotive, traction engine or road roller boiler having a heating surface -

(a) not exceeding 7.50 square metres	9.00	29.00
(b) exceeding 7.50 square metres	12.00	38.00

Boiler (other than a locomotive, traction engine or road roller boiler) having a heating surface including economizer and super-heater (if any) -

(a) not exceeding 2 square metres	4.50	10.20
(b) exceeding 2 square metres but not exceeding 5 square metres	6.00	17.00
(c) exceeding 5 square metres but not exceeding 15 square metres	9.00	26.00
(d) exceeding 15 square metres but not exceeding 80 square metres	12.00	36.00
(e) exceeding 80 square metres but not exceeding 250 square metres	14.25	48.00
(f) exceeding 250 square metres but not exceeding 500 square metres	18.00	64.00

Boiler (other than a locomotive, traction engine or road roller boiler) having a heating surface, including economizer and super-heater (if any), exceeding 500 square metres	18.00 plus 30 cents for each 100 square metres or part of 100 square metres by which the heating surface exceeds 500 square metres	64.00 plus \$2.40 for each 100 square metres or part of 100 square metres by which the heating surface exceeds 500 square metres
