MOTOR VEHICLE (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 1 of 1983

The Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations (Amendment), Regulations 1983 No. 1 made under the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936 amended the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations in accordance with the recommendations of the ACT Third Party Insurance Premiums Advisory Committee to vary the maximum premiums which may be charged.

The maximum premium that may be charged in respect of a third party policy in relation to a trader's plate has been reduced from \$189.00 to \$180.00.

The First Schedule of the Regulations has been amended by substituting a new Part II which, with the exception of items 9(c) and 14, decreases the maximum premium that may be charged in respect of a third party policy in relation to a motor vehicle of any classification expressed in Part I of the Schedule. The following table lists the motor vehicle classifications and sets out in respect of each the maximum premium payable.
