## MOTOR VEHICLE (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS

### EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 6 of 1980

The Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations 1980 No. made under the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936 increase the maximum premiums which may be charged in accordance with the recommendation of the ACT Third Party Insurance Premiums Advisory Committee.

Regulation 16 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations (the principal Regulations) is amended to increase the maximum premium that may be charged in respect of a third party policy in relation to a trader's plate, from \$131.00 to \$150.00.

The First Schedule of the principal Regulations is amended by substitution of a new Part II to increase the maximum premium that may be charged in respect of a third party policy in relation to a motor vehicle of any classification expressed in Part I of that Schedule. The following table lists the motor vehicle classifications and sets out in respect of each the previous maximum premium and the amended maximum premium.
