EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The purpose of the *Building Act 2004* is to regulate buildings and building work and other purposes.

Section 150 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2011-172, which set fees for the 2011-12 financial year and to determine fees for the 2012-13 financial year. In addition, this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2004-192 which set government building certification fees from 1 July 2004.

The majority of fees determined for the 2012-13 financial year represent the 2011-12 financial year fees increased in accordance with ACT Treasury's inflation factor of 3.5%. Appropriate rounding has occurred in relation to the increases.

The fees take effect on 1 July 2012.

The determination under section 150 of the Act is a Disallowable Instrument.
