The amendments to the Commonwealth Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations will prescribe new fares to be charged in respect of a journey on various Commonwealth Motor Omnibus services and will extend the concession fares to school children who attend school on a part time basis and who are below the age of fifteen years. It will also extend concession fares to students of the Canberra College of Advanced Education.

The amendments to the Commonwealth Motor Omnibus Services Regulations will define stopping places on the limited stop service between the Woden Interchange and Canberra City and make consequential amendments.
