## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

#### **Overview/ Detail**

The Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000 have been amended to insert provisions to allow for a 50km/h default speed limit in a built up area. As a consequence, amendments are made to the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000 to allow for exemption from Australian Road Rule ARR 25(2).
