JURIES FEES REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 12 of 1966

The regulations are made under the Juries Ordinance 1932-1951 and provide for increases in the fees payable to jurors in the Australian Capital Territory. The new fees are in line with those payable in the States, and the increases effected by the regulations are as follows:—

For each day of attendance not exceeding four hours from time of attending .....	2. 70	4. 00 (or, if the Registrar is satisfied that the person has incurred a financial loss in excess of \$4, the amount of that loss, or \$8, whichever is the less)
For each day of attendance of more than four hours, up to three days .....	4. 80	8. 00
For the fourth and every subsequent day's attendance of more than four hours .....	5. 40	10. 00
