AMENDMENTS OF THE LEASES REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 13 of 1955

These regulations –

- (a) bring the definition of “Returned Soldier” up to date,
- (b) provide that leases for grazing, fruit-growing, horticultural, dairying or agricultural purposes shall be for a period not exceeding fifty years and in other cases for a period not exceeding ninety-nine years,
- (c) omit the restriction on the value of land which may be held by one person, and
- (d) correct an error in regulation 9.
