APPOINTMENT AGENTS BOARD OF THE ACT

INSTRUMENT NO. 164 OF 2001

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Agents Board of the ACT is a body corporate constituted under the *Agents Act 1968* and reports to the Attorney-General.

The role of the Agents Board is to act as the licensing authority for the real estate, stock and station, business, travel and employment agent industries in the ACT. In discharging this function, the aim of the Board is to ensure that consumer interests are protected.

The composition of the Board is determined by the Act. The Board consists of members appointed by the Minister. Members are appointed for periods of up to three years as part-time statutory office holders.

This instrument appoints Mr Peter Crowley as a member of the Board (subsection 9 (2) of the Act) and Chair (subsection 10 (1) of the Act).

This Instrument of Appointment was prepared following consultation with the Legislative Assembly Committee nominated by the Speaker, as required by the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*.
