Race and Sports Bookmaking (Sports Bookmaking Venues) Determination 2013 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2013-7

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001 (the Act) regulates the activities of sports bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

Part 3 of the Act provides for the conduct and control of sports bookmaking. In particular, section 21(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may determine a place to be a sports bookmaking venue for the purpose of the Act.

This instrument revokes determination DI2008-193 dated 29 July 2008 and notified under the Legislation Register on 31 July 2008. The determination approves the ACTTAB Limited Agencies in the Schedule to the Instrument as approved sports bookmaking venues.

The determination has been amended to reflect a change in the operational status of a previously approved ACTTAB Agency. The Agency formerly located at Shop 9, Lanyon Marketplace, Conder 2906, has been removed from the Schedule of determined ACTTAB agencies as the venue is no longer operational.

In all other respects the Instrument has not been altered.
