

## Explanatory Statement

# Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods (Fees) Determination 2013 (No 2)

### Disallowable Instrument DI2013-311

made under the

**Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2008, s 197 (Determination of fees)**

---

This Determination of Fees revokes and replaces the Determination of Fees DI2013-301, dated 21 November 2013. Due to an administrative error DI2013-301 contained the same fees as DI2012-264, instead of the indexed fees as per below.

The Determination comes into effect on 1 January 2014 and increases the fees by the Wage Price Indexation rate of 3.0% (rounded to the nearest dollar), as set out below:
