Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation Declaration 2013 (No 7)

Disallowable instrument DI2013—315

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 12 (Power to include or exclude areas in road transport legislation)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Subsection 12(1) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* (the Act) empowers the Minister to declare that a provision of the road transport legislation does not apply to a road or road related area. Subsection 12(3) of the Act makes such a declaration a disallowable instrument.

Clauses 1 and 2 of the instrument are formal provisions dealing with the name and commencement of the instrument.

Clause 3 disapplies Australian Road Rule 205 (Parking for longer than indicated) from roads and road related areas that are controlled by non-pay time limited parking signs, around Manuka Oval. Schedule 1 of the instrument identifies the area that contains these roads and road related areas.

Clause 4 provides that the declaration has effect in relation to the Prime Minister's XI cricket match and AFL events held at Manuka Oval on 14 January 2014 from 11.00am to 11.59pm, 20 February 2014 from 4.00pm to 10.00pm, 12 April 2014 from 1.00pm to 9.00pm, 3 May 2014 from 11.00am to 6.00pm and 9 August 2014 from 11.00am to 6.00pm. The purpose of the clause is to enable motorists attending the cricket and AFL events to park in non-pay time limited parking spaces for a longer period of time than that specified on the parking sign.

Clause 5 explains that the declaration expires on 10 August 2014.
