Canberra Institute of Technology Act 1987, section 32 (Appointment of chair and deputy chair)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Canberra Institute of Technology Act 1987* governs the establishment, functions and membership of the Canberra Institute of Technology Advisory Council (the Council).

Section 32 of the Act enables the Minister to appoint a council member as chair and deputy chair of the council.

The Minister for Education and Training, Joy Burch MLA, has appointed Mr Peter McGrath as deputy chair of the Council from the day after notification until 31 December 2014. Mr McGrath is currently a member of the Council. His appointment began on 13 September 2012 for a period of three years.

The appointee is not a public servant and this instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001*, Division 19.3.3, applies. Accordingly, the instrument is a disallowable instrument under the *Legislation Act 2001*, section 229.

The Standing Committee on Education, Training and Youth Affairs has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly Committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
