EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Planning and Development Act 2007* established the Land Development Agency (LDA) to develop land, to carry out works for the development and enhancement of land, and to carry out strategic complex urban development projects.

Section 42 of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* together with section 78 (7) (b) of the *Financial Management Act 1996* enable the Minister to appoint Members to the Land Agency Board. The Minister has appointed Ms Chris Purdon as a member of the Land Agency Board commencing on the day after notification and expiring on 30 June 2017.

The appointment has been approved by Government and the Standing Committee on Planning, Public Works and Territory and Municipal Services has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (Consultation with appropriate Assembly Committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
