EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 88 of the *Animal Diseases Act 2005* (the Act) permits the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This determination revokes the previous fee determination (DI2014–167) that set fees for the 2014-2015 financial year and establishes fees from 1 July 2015.

The determination only sets a fee for the issuing of National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) devices (as defined in the *Animal Diseases Regulation 2006*) in emergency circumstances. In normal circumstances the issuing and recording of NLIS devices is a commercial transaction between the supplier of the device and the person requiring the device and no fee is required to be set under the Act.

The determination increases fees by 4% taking into consideration rounding for cash handling purposes.

The determination takes effect on 1 July 2015.
