

Road Transport (General) Numberplate Fees Determination 2015 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2015–96

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This disallowable instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for transactions relating to vehicle numberplates and the rights to registration numbers issued under the road transport legislation.

Numberplate fees have been increased by the Wages Price Index (WPI) of 2.75%, rounded down to the nearest ten cents. The transfer of rights fee for European style numberplates has been clarified to provide that a person purchasing a vehicle with “standard” European style numberplates is not liable to pay a transfer of rights fee.

Column 1 of schedule 1 lists the item number. Column 2 of schedule 1 describes the service or other matter in relation to the fee payable. Column 3 of schedule 1 lists the fee payable on or before 30 June 2015. Column 4 of schedule 1 lists the fee payable on or after 1 July 2015.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
