Road Transport (General) Driver Licence and Related Fees Determination 2016 (No 1)

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* authorises the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This disallowable instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for driver licence and related transactions under the road transport legislation.

For driver licence periods commencing on or after 1 July 2016, fees are increased by 5%, rounded down to the nearest ten cents, with the five year licence fee rounded down further to \$180. All other driver licence related fees have increased by the Wages Price Index (WPI) of 1.6%, rounded down to the nearest ten cents.

Column 1 of schedule 1 lists the item number for which a fee is payable. Column 2, part 1 of schedule 1 describes the service or other matter in relation to the fee payable. Column 3 of schedule 1 lists the fee payable for a driver licence period commencing on or before 30 June 2016. Column 4 of schedule 1 lists the fee payable for a driver licence period commencing on or after 1 July 2016.

Item 10 has been moved from part 1 of schedule 1 to part 2 of schedule 1 because it is a miscellaneous driver licence related fee.

Item 13 has been amended to clarify the circumstances under which a replacement driver licence fee is payable.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
