REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

INSTRUMENT NO. 29 OF 2001

This Instrument revokes Instrument No.184 of 2000, dated 19th June 2000 and notified in Gazette No. S25 on 20 June 2000.

It has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for transactions relating to vehicle registration under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*. Registration fees for all types of vehicles are unchanged.

The only change is to introduce a new administration fee of \$30.00 for *re*-registrations of vehicles. Previously the one administration fee of \$57.00 applied to ‘original’ registrations. There are now two separate fees: one for the establishment of a vehicle registration record for the first time and one for re-activating a previously existing registration record that has lapsed. The ‘establish registration’ fee remains at \$57.00. The new re-registration fee is lower at \$30.00 to reflect the lower level of administration work required for the transaction.
