EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2008* establishes an authorisation and licensing framework for medicines and poisons.

This instrument revokes and replaces DI2016-286, notified on 5 December 2016.

This instrument sets fees for the application of licences under the Act, as well for the amendment or replacement of licences. The Determination comes into effect on 1 January 2018 and increases the fees by 4.0% (rounded to the nearest dollar), as set out below:
