## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission is responsible for variation of utility licences under Section 38 of the *Utilities Act 2000*.

ActewAGL Distribution has requested a variation to its electricity distribution, connection and transmission licence under section 38(1)(a) of the Act. The variation sought to take account of a trading name change from ActewAGL Distribution to Evoenergy that will come into effect on 1 January 2018.

The Commission has approved the variations to ActewAGL Distribution's electricity licence to take effect as of 1 January 2018.

Details of the variation are documented in schedule 2 of the licence.
