EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 12 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* empowers the Minister to declare that the road transport legislation does not apply to a road or road related area for a period stated in the declaration. Such a notice is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.

This instrument declares that the road transport legislation does not apply to roads and road related areas that are to be used by a single rally car on 17 and 18 October 2000 to conduct rally testing. The declaration will also have the effect of minimising the risk of claims against the Territory for injuries arising from this testing.

For the purposes of the declaration, the road and road related areas specified in it include an area of land radiating in all directions in a straight line fifty (50) metres from the centre of the roads.

Road and Road Related Areas:

The road commences at the start point identified by ACT standard grid coordinates (ACTSGC) E192230 and N590130 and continues in a generally east-northeasterly direction along the northern boundary of compartment 184 to ACTSGC E192380 and N590170.

The road continues in a southerly and easterly direction along the northeastern boundary of compartment 184 to ACTSGC E192615 and N590010, and then follows the northern boundary of compartment 183 in an easterly direction to ACTSGC E192760 and N590020.

The road then follows the northern and eastern boundaries of compartment 183 in a generally easterly and southerly direction to ACTSGC E192850 and N589710, and then continues along the southern boundary of compartment 183 in a generally easterly direction to ACTSGC E192405 and N589555.

The road then continues in a northwesterly direction along the southwestern boundary of compartment 183 to ACTSGC E192200 and N599710, and then continues in a generally northeasterly direction along the northwestern boundary of compartment 183 to ACTSGC E192615 and N590010.
