EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Health Act 1997* provides for the licensing and registration of public health risk activities.

This instrument sets fees for the application, renewal and transfer of all licensable or registrable public health risk activities.

This instrument revokes and replaces DI2018-260, notified on 25 October 2018.

This instrument comes into effect on 1 January 2020 and increases the fees by Wage Price Index of 2.5% (rounded to the nearest dollar), as set out below:
