PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1997

Explanatory Statement

Determination of Notifiable Conditions

Subsection 100 (1) of the *Public Health Act 1997* provides that the Minister may, by instrument, determine—

- (a) a disease or medical condition to be a notifiable condition; and
- (b) a disease referred to in paragraph (a) to be a transmissible notifiable condition.

This determination lists, in schedule 1, diseases or medical conditions determined to be notifiable conditions. This determination also lists, in schedule 2, those diseases in schedule 1 that are determined to be transmissible notifiable conditions.

This determination is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of Section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.
