### **PAROLE ACT 1976**

### **APPOINTMENT**

### **INSTRUMENT NO. 309 of 2000**

#### EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Parole Act 1976* (the Act), amongst other things, governs the constitution and functions of the Parole Board of the ACT (the Board). The Board's function is to consider and make orders about the release of prisoners on parole, and the discipline of parolees. The establishment and constitution of the Board is provided for by section 9 of the Act. This requires that the Minister appoint a Chairperson and four other members, one of whom will be female and one of whom will be male. Section 9A stipulates that appointments may be for a period not exceeding three years.

This instrument appoints Federal Agent Audrey Fagan as a member of the Board for three years from the date of its notification in the Gazette. This appointment fills a vacancy left following the resignation of a former member this year.

In accordance with Section 6 of the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*, this instrument is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of Section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989* as Federal Agent Audrey Fagan is not an ACT public servant.
