The Instrument of Approval has been prepared in accordance with section 10 (3) of the *Blood Donation (Transmittable Diseases) Act 1985.*

Section 5 of *the Act,* specifies that for sections 3 and 4, the prescribed requirements, in relation to the taking of blood from a donor, are:

(a) that, before taking blood from the donor, the society gets from the donor a written declaration.

The Australian Red Cross Blood Service-ACT has made changes to the Donor Declaration Form to achieve national conformity in the spirit of a truly national blood service sector.

The ACT branch of the Australian Red Cross Blood Service will implement the use of the revised Donor Declaration Form on 8 September 2003.

NB: An approved form for a declaration under section 5 (a) is a disallowable instrument. On advice from PCO this Instrument contains both a formal AF and DI number.
