**DETERMINATION OF CONCESSIONS**  
**INSTRUMENT No. 284 OF 2000**  
**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This Instrument determines the method to be used to work out a fee payable by persons eligible for a concession in relation to fees payable for vehicle registration and driver licensing.

It is to apply to the currently determined fees and will be ongoing. It is envisaged that this determination will not be altered on a regular basis as fees and charges are, but will continue and will only be amended when the need arises.

The categories of people entitled to a concession as described in the Schedule are:

- Pensioner Concession Card holders (cards issued by DVA and Centrelink).
- Repatriation health card (gold card) holders (card issued by DVA);
- Senior Card Holders;
- Senior Card Holders with a gas/electric powered vehicle;
- Primary Producers;
- Primary Producers with a gas/electric powered vehicle;
- Registered operators with a gas/electric vehicle;
- A person unemployed for more than six months who is a holder of a Health Care Card.

This instrument applies from 1 October 2000, and comes into force immediately for all renewals of driver licence and vehicle registration where the previous expiry date of the licence or registration is on or after 30 September 2000.
