APPOINTMENT TO THE CLEANING INDUSTRY LONG SERVICE LEAVE BOARD

INSTRUMENT NO. 255 OF 2000

The Cleaning Industry Long Service Leave Board was established by section 5 of the Long Service Leave (Cleaning, Building and Property Services) Act 1999 ("the Act"). Section 5 commenced on 23 December 1999.

Subsection 10 (1) of the Act, which also commenced on 23 December 1999, stipulates that the Board shall consist of (a) the Chairperson; (b) a member representing employer organisations; and (c) a member representing employee organisations.

By subsection 10 (2) of the Act, which also commenced on 23 December 1999, the members of the Board are to be appointed by the Minister and shall hold office for up to 5 years, as stated in the member's appointment.

The following are instruments of appointment for Robert Yeomans, Jacqui Burke and Lyndal Ryan as members of the Board, and Rodney Barnes and Christine Wagland as acting members of the Board, for three years from 14 July 2000.

Pursuant to section 4 of the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994*, these appointments were endorsed by the Legislative Assembly's Standing Committee on Planning and Urban Services on 21 June 2000.
