The *Public Health Act 1997* provides for the licensing and registration of public health risk activities.

This instrument sets fees for the application, renewal and transfer of all licensable or registrable public health risk activities.

This instrument revokes and replaces DI2019-250, notified on 7 November 2019.

This instrument comes into effect on 1 January 2022 and increases the fees by Wage Price Index of 1.75% (rounded to the nearest dollar), as set out below:
