EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Associations Incorporation Act 1991 governs the incorporation of associations in the Australian Capital Territory. In particular, section 126 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act and section 125 specifies matters in the Act for which a determined fee is payable

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 162 of 1999 made on 28 June 1999 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S38 of 30 June 1999 and determines that the various fees payable under the Act, including fees for lodging for registration and searching documents, shall be as set out in the Schedule to the Determination.

The fees determined for items 1 & 11 have been increased by a margin of 2.5% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 2000/01 of the Consumer Price Index and with a view to full cost recovery.

The fees determined for items 2 - 10 have not been increased as the CPI adjustment is less than 50 cents.

A statement of the old and new fees is attached.
