## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997 establishes the Cultural Facilities Corporation.

Governing board members of the Cultural Facilities Corporation are appointed under section 9 of the *Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997* (see also section 78 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* for member appointments).

This instrument appoints Shad Sears as a member of the governing board. The appointment begins on the day after it is notified and ends on 31 December 2024.

The appointee is not a Public Servant, making this an instrument to which the *Legislation Act* 2001, Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under the *Legislation Act* 2001, s 229, the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

This reappointment has been approved by the Minister for the Arts, and the Standing Committee on Economy and Gender and Economic Equality has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (Consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
