REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES
EXPLANATORY STATEMENT
INSTRUMENT No. 175 OF 2000

This Determination made under section 63 of the Animal Diseases Act 1993 (the Act) revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets the fees for the purposes of the Act.

The Animal Diseases Act 1993 ('the Act') provides for the control of endemic and exotic diseases of animals and for related purposes.

Under Section 63 of the Animal Diseases Act 1993 the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine fees for the purposes of the Act. This Instrument sets out a fee for the provision of emergency tail tags in case the original tags are missing at the point of sale or slaughter. The tags are used for disease tracing.
