EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

INSTRUMENT No. 145 OF 2000

This Determination made under section 9A of the **Roads and Public Places Act 1937** (the Act) revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets the fees for the purposes of the Act.

The purpose of the fee is to allow builders to use unleased Territory land for storage and other purposes under a short term licence arrangement during the construction of a development.
