AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY ROAD TRANSPORT (GENERAL) ACT 1999 DETERMINATION OF TAXI FARES INSTRUMENT NO. 115 OF 2000 EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes Determination No. 302 of 1999 dated 20 December 1999 and published in the ACT Special Gazette No. 68 of 22 December 1999

Section 115(1) of the Road Transport (General) Act 1999 specifies that the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine the maximum fares chargeable for the hiring of a taxi. This notice is a disallowable instrument in the Legislative Assembly.

This determination reflects the introduction of a toll for those taxi services where a toll has been paid by the taxi driver at the Canberra International Airport. The toll will take effect from 17 April 2000.

This determination makes no change to the fees for Flagfall, Kilometre Rates, Waiting Time, Radio Booking or High Occupancy Surcharge, however the special one-off surcharge for New Year's Eve 1999 has been deleted.

HIGH OCCUPANCY SURCHARGE

For the carriage of a group of 6 or more passengers to a common hiring destination, that is not the subject of a multiple hiring, the maximum fare is the single rate plus fifty per cent (50%) of that rate.
