DETERMINATION OF FEES

INSTRUMENT NO. 96 OF 2000

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Liquor Act governs the sale and consumption of liquor in the ACT. Section 179 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act. This Determination revokes the Determination of Fees of 1999 dated 20 October 1999 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Special Gazette No. S 42 of 20 October 1999 and determines new fees for the purpose of the Act.

The determination effectively determines the fee required to be paid for the issue of a proof of age card. All other fees previously determined under the Act are not amended by this determination. A statement of the old and new fees is hereunder. The references to the sections under which the fees are payable have been amended to reflect the renumbering of the Act that occurred under the Legislation (Republication) Act 1996.
