EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Health Act 1997 provides for the licensing and registration of public health risk activities.

This instrument sets fees for the application, renewal and transfer of all licensable or registrable public health risk activities.

This instrument revokes and replaces DI2022-248, notified on 21 November 2022.

This instrument comes into effect on 1 January 2024 and increases the fees by Wage Price Index of 3.75% (rounded to the nearest 5 cents) as set out below:
