INSTRUMENT NO. 71 OF 2000

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

As a result of the repeal of the *Motor Traffic Act 1936* and related legislation, all fees and charges are re-determined under the new Road Transport Legislation.

This instrument has the effect of fixing maximum fees for inspections or tests of motor vehicles and trailers carried out by authorised examiners in approved authorised premises for the purposes of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000*.

The legislation regulates inspections by authorised examiners in approved authorised premises who conduct vehicle inspections for registration purposes of motor vehicles and trailers with a GVM not exceeding 4.5 tonnes.

Set out below are the same as the maximum fees agreed to by Government in April 1997 (for a period of 3 years) to be charged by a proprietor of an approved authorised premises for performing inspections or tests of motor vehicles or trailers.

These fees commence on 1 March 2000.
