DETERMINATION OF FEES

INSTRUMENT NO. 174 OF 1999

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Lotteries Act 1964 (the Act) provides for the regulation of the conduct of lotteries in the Territory, including raffles, silver circles, housie and trade promotions.

In particular section 7AA of the Act, deals with the application for a variation to an approved lottery. Subsection 7AA(2) of the Act requires a written request and a fee for a variation to a lottery approval.

This determination under section 18A of the Act, for the purposes of subsection 7AA(2), sets the fee that shall accompany an application for a variation to a lottery approval at \$30 and applies on and from 1 July 1999.

This fee is being introduced to partly recover the administrative costs of processing amendments to lottery applications and approvals.
