AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY ADOPTION REGULATIONS DETERMINATION OF FEES INSTRUMENT NO. 156 OF 1999

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Adoption Act 1993, regulates the adoption of children in the Australian Capital Territory. Section 121 empowers the Executive to make regulations for the purposes of the Act.

Part VII of the Adoption Regulations deals with the registration of adoptions and regulation 24 enables an adopted person born in a foreign country or his or her adoptive parent/s to apply for a certificate of an entry in the register of births. Further, regulation 31 enables the Minister to determine fees for the purpose of the Regulations.

The appropriate fee, determined for the purposes of S.43 of the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1997, is \$27, having been increased from \$26 by a margin of 2.5% in accordance with the anticipated movement in 1999/2000 of the Consumer Price Index and with a view to full cost recovery.
