EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Health Promotion Act 1995* governs the establishment, composition and functions of the ACT Health Promotion Board.

Section 10(1) of the Act deals with the appointment of members and requires such appointments to be made by the Minister, for a period of three years.

The instruments appoint a Chairperson and Members to the ACT Health Promotion Board for a period of three years from the date of gazettal.

In accordance with Section 4 of the *Statutory Appointments Act 1994* the Standing Committee for Health and Community Care was consulted on the appointments.
