

# Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Governing Board Deputy Chair Appointment 2025 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2025–64

made under the

***Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Act 2009*, s79E (Establishment of governing board) and *Financial Management Act 1996*, s 79 (Appointment of chair and deputy chair)**

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

This instrument appoints Roslyn Jackson as an independent member and deputy chair to the Long Service Leave Governing Board (the Board) commencing on the day after notification.

Section 79E of the *Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Act 2009* (the Act) establishes the Board. Section 79F of the Act establishes the appointment of members to the Board and section 79G establishes that a deputy chair must be appointed for the Board.

Roslyn Jackson is appointed to the Board under section 79E of the Act as an independent member and deputy chair in accordance with sections 79F (2) (c) and section 79G of the Act. Section 79 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* allows the Minister to appoint a deputy chair.

The appointee is not a public servant, and this instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001* (the Legislation Act), Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under section 229 of the Legislation Act, the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

This appointment has been made by the Minister and the Standing Committee on Economics, Industry and Recreation has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

Section 78 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* provides that an appointment of a member must be for a term of no longer than three years unless the establishing Act allows for a longer period. While section 79F (5) of the establishing Act provides for terms up to five years, the appointment of Roslyn Jackson is for a term of four (4) years.
