

Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Governing Board Employee Representative Appointment 2025 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2025–66

made under the

***Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Act 2009*, section 79E (Establishment of governing board) (see also *Financial Management Act 1996*, s 78)**

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument appoints Pema Choden as an employee representative member to the Long Service Leave Governing Board (the Board) commencing on the day after notification.

Section 79E of the *Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Act 2009* (the Act) establishes the Governing Board. Section 79F of the Act establishes criteria for the appointment of members to the Governing Board.

Pema Choden is appointed to the Board under section 79E of the Act as an employer representative member in accordance with sections 79F (2) (b) of the Act. Section 78 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* allows the Minister to appoint Governing Board members generally.

The appointee is not a public servant, and this instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001* (the Legislation Act), Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under section 229 of the Legislation Act, the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

This appointment has been made by the Minister and the Standing Committee on Economics, Industry and Recreation has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

Section 78 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* provides that an appointment of a member must be for a term of no longer than three years unless the establishing Act allows for a longer period. While section 79F (5) of the establishing Act provides for terms up to five years, the appointment of Pema Choden is for a term of four (4) years.
