DETERMINATION OF FEES

INSTRUMENT NO. 101 OF 1999

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Liquor Act governs the sale and consumption of liquor in the ACT. Section 105A enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act. This Determination revokes the Determination of Fees No 152 of 1998 dated 26 May 1998 and notified in the Australian Capital Territory Special Gazette No. S 173 of 1 July 1998 and determines new fees for the purpose of the Act.

The fees have generally been increased by 2.5% in line with the anticipated movement in 1999/2000 of the Consumer Price Index. Permit fees were restructured in January 1998 and are unchanged as are the fees for the issue of a proof of age card. A statement of the old and new fees is hereunder.
