EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 54F of the *Utilities Act 2000* requires the Levy Administrator, appointed under section 54N, to determine the amount of local regulatory costs to be applied to each energy industry sector.

The *Utilities* (Energy industry levy – local regulatory costs) Determination 2025 sets out the costs determined by the Levy Administrator.

Local regulatory costs are made up of costs to the Territory of

- providing regulatory activities in relation to safety, technical operations, consumer service and environmental behaviour for energy utility services; and
- the administration of the levy.

The costs relate to the work of the:

- Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission
- Utilities Technical Regulator
- ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal.
